

Clean Slate Information

Individuals will **not** be notified when their conviction(s) are automatically set aside. Individuals may confirm whether their conviction has been set aside using ICHAT or requesting a personal record review through MSP.

According to MSP, Running an ICHAT report costs \$10.00 per search. An individual running a criminal history record in ICHAT will only have access to public records- they are **unable to view or access set aside convictions**.

According to MSP, a personal record review requires the submission of fingerprints and a \$30.00 processing fee but will include a complete criminal history record **including both public and nonpublic convictions**.

If you believe a conviction should have been automatically set aside, but it is still publicly available on ICHAT, the individual needs to contact the MSP at MSP-CRD-CSAAUTOMATIC@michigan.gov.
